

Turkish Power Plant Plans

Zorlu Enerji Elektrik Uretim, a Turkish power utility, will start producing electricity at one of its two gas-fired plant projects in Moscow by the end of this year, company head Murat Sungur Bursa said Tuesday.

City Hall said in May that Zorlu did not deliver the Tereshkovo and Kozhukhovo plants, valued at \$1.2 billion, on time and demanded their completion "as soon as possible."
