

Novaya Gazeta Gets Leaks

December 22, 2010



Novaya Gazeta said Wednesday that it has agreed to join forces with Wiki-Leaks to expose corruption in Russia.

WikiLeaks founder Julian Assange has materials specifically about Russia that have not been published yet, and Novaya Gazeta will help make them public, the newspaper said.

Novaya Gazeta received unlimited access to the WikiLeaks database, which has a "wide range" of materials, including documents about Anna Politkovskaya's murder in 2006 as well as information about Russian politicians' ties to organized crime, newspaper spokeswoman Nadezhda Prusenkova said by phone. The newspaper will start releasing materials next month.
