

VimpelCom Mulls Dividend

VimpelCom could pay an additional \$250 million in dividends for the 2010 financial year, which would bring the entire payment to \$850 million, the company said.

VimpelCom decided in November to pay interim dividends at \$0.46 per American Depositary Receipt (one ADR equals a common share), which put the entire dividend payment at \$600 million.

According to terms set in the agreement for the acquisition of Wind Telecom from Egyptian billionaire Naguib Sawiris, VimpelCom will pay up to \$850 million in dividends for 2010. The current owners of Wind, including Sawiris, will not have the right to receive those funds.
