

Cirque Invests \$57M

Canadian circus company Cirque du Soleil will invest a record \$57 million in a new show in Moscow next year to test the ground before launching a permanent show in Russia by 2015, its president said Monday.

"Zarkana" is Cirque du Soleil's first new show in Russia and will be the most expensive nonpermanent show the company has ever made to date, Daniel Lamarre told reporters.

Zarkana will premiere at the Kremlin Palace in February 2012 and run for nine weeks.
