

20 Killed in Ingushetia

At least 17 rebels and three law enforcement officers were killed Monday in clashes at a suspected terrorist camp in Ingushetia, RIA-Novosti reported.

Air and ground strikes were carried out in connection with an ongoing search for people involved in a January bomb blast at Moscow's Domodedovo Airport that killed 37. "According to preliminary data, at least 17 militants have been killed ... and two suspects in the Domodedovo blast have been detained," said Nikolai Sentsov, a spokesman for the National Anti-Terror Committee, RIA-Novosti reported. Two Federal Security Service officers and a police officer were killed, the report said.
