

Weekend Road Closures

September 01, 2011



Traffic will be restricted throughout the city center this weekend in connection with the City Day holiday. To view a map (in Russian) of planned road closings, <u>click here</u>.

Sept. 3

From 8 a.m. to 4 p.m., in connection with the International University Regatta, traffic will be restricted on Frunzenskaya Naberezhnaya between 1st Frunzenskaya Ulista and 2nd Frunzenskaya Ulitsa. Titovsky Proyezd will be closed from Leninsky Prospekt to Pushkinskaya Naberezhnaya.

Sept. 4

From 8 a.m. to 11 p.m., traffic will be restricted on Tverskaya Ulitsa from Triumfalnaya Ploshchad to Ulitsa Okhotny Ryad, as well as on Ulitsa Okhotny Ryad, Mokhovaya Ulitsa, Teatralny Proyezd, Lubyanskaya Ulitsa and Novaya Ploshchad.

From 2:30 p.m. to 6 p.m., due to the Moscow Students' Parade, traffic will be restricted on the following streets: Tverskaya, Mokhovaya, Serafimovicha, Bolshaya Polyanka and Bolshaya

Yakimanka. Restrictions will also be in place on Krymsky Val (from the direction of Gorky Park), Borovitskaya and Kaluzhskaya squares, the Bolshoi Kamenny Bridge and Pushkinskaya Naberezhnaya.

From 4:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m., in connection with the International University Regatta, traffic will be restricted on Fruzenskaya Naberezhnaya between 1st Fruzenskaya Ulitsa to 2nd Fruzenskaya Ulitsa.

Beginning at 10 p.m., in connection with the fireworks show, traffic will be restricted along Moskvoretskaya Naberezhnaya, Vasilyevsky Spusk and the Bolshoi Moskvoretsky Bridge.

From 8 a.m. to midnight, in connection with the 3D show at Vorobyovy Gory, traffic along Ulitsa Kosygina and Universitetsky Prospekt (from Prospekt Vernadskogo to Michurinsky Prospekt) will be restricted.
