

Norilsk Fund in Scandal

A⊠multimillion-dollar fraud case has been brought by⊠the Interior Ministry against a group of managers of⊠Norilsk Nickel's pension fund accused of⊠stealing 137 million rubles (\$4.7 million), Interfax reported Tuesday.

In late January, the ■fund announced that it was preparing a ■statement for ■law enforcement in ■connection with large losses caused by ■poor management by ■the company's top executives, a ■team previously led by ■presidential candidate Mikhail Prokhorov.

The suspects in⊠the case gained access to⊠citizens' personal information, allowing them to⊠falsify statements and⊠agreements on transferring⊠savings into⊠their own accounts, Interior Ministry spokeswoman Irina Volk told Interfax. They face maximum penalties of⊠10 years in⊠prison and⊠a 1 million ruble fine.
