

Lanit Hit With Tax Bill

The Moscow arbitration court is scheduled Monday to hear a claim filed by Lanit against the Federal Tax Service Interregional Inspectorate No. 7, according to court documents, Vedomosti reported.

The IT company is disputing a decision made by the tax authority after a field audit of the company for 2007-08.

The tax service claims Lanit created a scheme to evade VAT payments, resulting in a budget loss of about 1.99 billion rubles (\$67.5 million). Total claims, including penalties and interest, came to 2.89 billion rubles. Tax officers made similar claims in 2005–06, but the courts sided with the company, which declared turnover in 2011 of 58.7 billion rubles.
