

A Third of Ministers on Twitter; Fakes Tweet Obscenities

About one third of Cabinet ministers have Twitter accounts.

About one third of the new government's ministers have entered the age of social media with Twitter accounts, while several others have been impersonated by swearing virtual fraudsters.

The actively tweeting officials include not only Prime Minister Dmitry Medvedev, who opened his account at Twitter headquarters in San Francisco, but also another eight of the 28 total Cabinet ministers.

The most popular user — after the prime minister, who has more than 1 million followers — is Deputy Prime Minister Arkady Dvorkovich, a former presidential aide to Medvedev and close ally in the government's modernization push. Deputy Prime Minister Dmitry Rogozin comes in third by number of followers, with more than 79,000, far outstripping last place tweeter Deputy Prime Minister Olga Golodets, who only opened her account after taking her new job in late May and has attracted a little over 150 followers.

Not all the ministers follow each other on the microblogging service, RBC Daily noted. Sports Minister Vitaly Mutko, for example, follows only two accounts — those of the prime minister and the Kremlin.

Some accounts for ministers are fake, having been opened by unknown users. Fake accounts for both Deputy Prime Minister Vladislav Surkov and Defense Minister Anatoly Serdyukov publish comments using invectives laden with swear words criticizing both the "regime" and the alleged authors themselves. The fake account for Surkov has close to 1,000 followers, while the imposter Serdyukov account has less than one hundred followers.
