

Emirates Upgrades Service

DUBAI – Emirates airline will launch the first-ever scheduled A380 service to Moscow on Dec. 1, the company said. ■

The airline's 517-seat version of the A380 will replace the Boeing 777-300ER on one of its two daily flights to Domodedovo Airport. □ "Domodedovo is the first and the only Russian airport that meets the requirements of A380 operators," said Domodedovo director Igor Borisov. "We are fully prepared to handle A380 flights on a regular basis, having purchased the unique equipment designed to serve only this type of aircraft."

In November, Emirates chose St. Petersburg as its second gateway into Russia.
