

Metalloinvest Profit Triples

Metalloinvest, controlled by the country's richest man, Alisher Usmanov, said its first-half net profit almost tripled, mainly due to the sale of its transportation business.

Its net profit rose to \$1.31 billion in the January-to-June period from \$457 million, which it reported for the second half of 2011. This spring, Metalloinvest sold Metalloinvesttrans to freight operator Globaltrans for \$569 million.

Metalloinvest's net debt rose 38 percent by the end of June to \$6.12 billion, the company said Friday.
