

LUKoil plans \$5Bln Investment in Uzbekistan

LUKoil, Russia's second-largest oil producer, plans to invest some \$5 billion in projects in Uzbekistan over the next five years, local media reported Wednesday.

The news came a day after talks between the Central Asian country's president, Islam Karimov, and LUKoil CEO Vagit Alekperov.

The privately owned company has invested \$3.2 billion in Uzbekistan's oil and natural gas sector since 2004, including \$500 million in January-September 2013.

LUKoil is currently engaged in three projects in Uzbekistan with a cumulative gas production of 20.5 billion cubic meters.
