

Alfa Bank Plans \$500 Million Eurobond Float Despite Ukraine Tensions

Russia's largest private bank Alfa Bank plans to issue subordinated eurobonds worth at least \$500 million in September, the bank's chief managing director told journalists Tuesday.

"We want [to do this] in September ... but the question is how the situation will develop in September," Alfa Bank's Alexei Marei said at a news conference. "If there is a deal then it will be more than \$500 million."
