

Russia's Central Bank Spends \$2.42 Billion to Defend Ruble

Russia's Central Bank said Tuesday it had conducted 102.3 billion rubles (\$2.42 billion) worth of forex interventions to defend the rouble on Oct. 24.

The Central Bank releases its interventions data with a time lag. The ruble has been sliding on falling oil prices and broad risk aversion towards Russia because of its role in the Ukraine crisis.
