

Russia's Ruble Seesaws at Opening as Falling Oil Prices Take Toll

The ruble opened slightly higher against the dollar and then weakened on Tuesday after plunging more than 6 percent a day earlier, dragged lower by weaker oil prices.

At 10:03 a.m. in Moscow, the ruble was down 0.3 percent against the dollar at 61.11 rubles and 0.2 percent weaker against the euro at 73.56.
