

Belarus Asks Russia for \$3 Billion Loan, Says Finance Minister

UFA — Belarus has asked Russia to provide a \$3 billion loan, and on Thursday the Russian government will decide on providing Belarus with a \$760 million tranche of an earlier approved credit line, Russian Finance Minister Anton Siluanov said Thursday.

Siluanov told journalists at a BRICS summit in the Russian city of Ufa that the decision on the new \$3 billion loan was not yet taken but that he expected the government to approve the \$760 million tranche.

"In July we will give them [Belarus] this money," Siluanov said, referring to the \$760 million sum.
