A recent poll by the All-Russia Public Opinion Research Center (VTsIOM) asked respondents how religion affected their lives, and whether they would be opposed to a religious building belonging to a faith they didn't practice opening in their neighborhood. The agency then compared the responses with data from 1990.

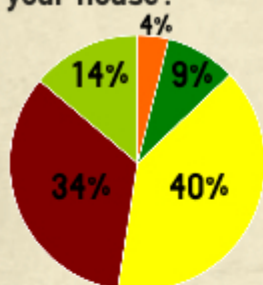

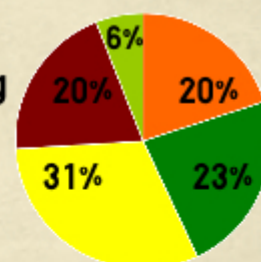

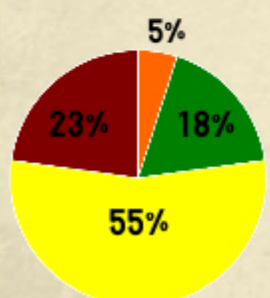
How would you react to the opening of a religious building (not of your own faith) near your house?



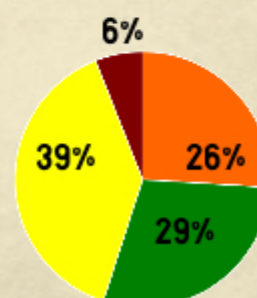
→ Would try to prevent it from happening
