

Russia's Interior Ministry Offers Reward for Information on Simferopol Shooter

Russia's Interior Ministry has offered a 500,000-ruble (\$7,625) reward for information leading to the arrest of a man suspected of opening fire at an <u>ambulance depot</u> in the Crimean city of Simferopol, killing three people.

Police are searching for local resident Bekir Nebiyev, 55, who is suspected of carrying out the attack, the Interior Ministry said in a statement Monday.

Nebiyev allegedly arrived at the depot on Saturday afternoon and opened fire on medics. The day after the attack, Crimea's police published a photo of Nebiyev and called on local residents to share any information about his possible whereabouts.
