

Top 4 Moscow Spots for an Ad Hoc Workout

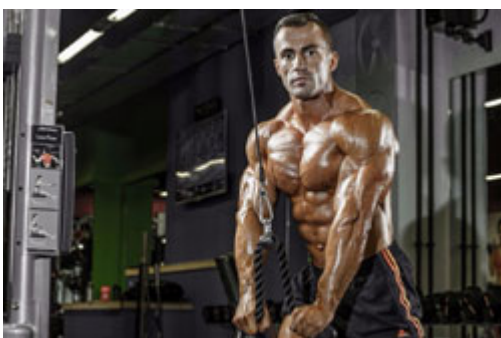

Fitness Cult, near Komsomolskaya metro, offers a good range of fitness classes from CrossFit to yoga. A one-visit pass for 1,100 rubles (\$14) will allow you access to the training room, one exercise class and a Finnish sauna afterwards. Sadly there is no swimming pool, but if you find a buddy during your workout, you can bond over healthful green juice shots at the fitness bar afterwards. Beauty salon also on site.

World-class swimming facilities

Don't worry, you don't need to be a world-class athlete to exercise here. Situated in the northeast of the city, the complex offers cutting-edge outdoor and indoor pools. A dip will cost you 350-400 rubles (\$4-5) depending on the time of day. A children's swimming pool, sauna area and various Jacuzzis mean there's something for everyone to enjoy. The more adventurous can opt for a lesson of water polo or aqua aerobics.

A one-visit pass will set you back 1,200 rubles (\$15), but does allow you to access the training room, swimming pool and then bask in the sauna afterwards. If you are feeling particularly energetic there are reasonably-priced personal training sessions available.
