

Twitter Outcry After Russian Footballers' Champagne Party

Russian social media has reacted angrily to videos showing two of the country's footballers partying extravagantly in Monaco.

Russian social media has <u>reacted angrily</u> to <u>videos</u> showing two of the country's footballers partying extravagantly in Monaco just days after the <u>national team crashed out</u> of the UEFA EURO 2016 tournament.

Alexander Kokorin, 25, and Pavel Mamaev, 27, were filmed smoking hookah and drinking champagne as the Russian national anthem played, sparklers sparkled and confetti flew in an exclusive Monte Carlo nightclub. According to reports, they ran up a staggering drinks bill of 250,000 euros (\$276,000).

Kokorin and Markin faced public condemnation **■** after their indulgent evening became known.

The pair's antics were a double insult to fans who had suffered through the team's abject failures on the field: "Spitting in the face of the supporters. Part 2."
