

Russian Military Begins Baltic Fleet Reinspection After Officer Purge

A⊠special military commission has begun its re-inspection of the Baltic⊠Fleet after its entire senior command was fired⊠in late June, the⊠TASS

news agency**⊠**reported Tuesday.

The re-inspection will check "progress in eliminating shortcomings" in the fleet which were revealed during a month-long Defense Ministry inspection last month, TASS reported.

The ministry⊠dismissed the fleet's entire senior and mid-level command after the⊠initial inspection, including fleet commander Vice Admiral Viktor⊠Kravchuk. Observers have tied the dismissals to incompetence and⊠corruption, including cover-ups and misuse of funds. The purge was⊠the largest mass-firings of naval officers since the Stalin era.

The Baltic Fleet⊠has come under renewed focus from Western officials' concerned⊠about a perceived Russian military threat in the region.
