

Russian Customs Offices Raided in Smuggling Investigation — Reports

Russia's ■ Federal Customs Service (FCS) has been raided as part of a criminal ■ investigation into illegal alcohol production, the Interfax news ■ agency reported Tuesday.

Federal Security Service (FSB) agents searched the office of FCS head Andrey Belyaninov as part of the case against St. Petersburg businessman ▶Dmitry Mikhalchenko.

FCS⊠employees are not under suspicion, Interfax reported.

Mikhalchenko⊠is accused of founding organized crime groups and illegally trading⊠alcohol.

He was ■arrested in March on suspicion of organizing the transportation of ■two containers of Courvoisier Cognac 1912. The shipment, believed to ■be worth a total of 2 million rubles (\$30,000), passed through the ■Baltic sea port of Ust Luga disguised as building sealant.

Russian \blacksquare law enforcement is yet to confirm the raid.
