

Clinton Overtakes Trump as Russian Media's Most Talked-About U.S. Presidential Candidate

U.S. Presidential nominee Hillary⊠Clinton has overtaken her Republican rival Donald Trump as the most⊠discussed candidate in the Russian media, the Interfax news agency ⊠reported Monday.

In the past three months, Democrat party candidate Clinton has been mentioned by the Russian media some 52,000 times. The figures gave her a significant lead on businessman Trump, who was mentioned just over 42,000 times.

The shift follows six months of Trump\(\mathbb{Z}\) dominating the Russian headlines, Interfax reported. The trend has been largely credited to\(\mathbb{Z}\) articles on a cyber-attack which saw Clinton's emails leaked, as well\(\mathbb{Z}\) as speculation on a possible health scare.

Clinton also dominated the Russian media following Sunday's second presidential debate. The Secretary of State had been mentioned 800 times as of 9 dam Moscow Time, while Donald Trump was mentioned just over 600 times.

Clinton has <u>previously claimed</u> that

Moscow would "celebrate" if Trump became U.S. president.
