

## Kremlin Eyes Better Ties With Bulgaria, Moldova After Pro-Russia Election Victories

The Kremlin is hoping to revive ties with Bulgaria and Moldova after both countries saw pro-Russia candidates elected as president,

the Interfax news agency reported Monday.

Bulgarian Rumen Radev and Moldovan Igor⊠Dodon were both victorious in their respective countries during⊠presidential elections on Sunday. Both pledged to restore better ties⊠with Moscow during their campaigns.

Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov⊠claimed that the Kremlin did not want to "fixate" on the⊠politicians' reported pro-Russia leanings, but said that the Russian⊠government was "impressed" with both leaders' "willingness to⊠enter dialogue."

Peskov also hinted that the election **■** could see the start of some joint Russian-Bulgarian projects, but **■** claimed that discarded plans to build a gas pipeline to Bulgaria were unlikely to be revived.
