

Russia's Sakha: Coldest Spot in the Northern Hemisphere

The coldest temperatures in the northern hemisphere have been recorded **\Z**in Sakha, the location of the Oymyakon valley, where according to the **\Z**United Kingdom Met Office a temperature of minus 67.8 degrees Celsius **\Z**was registered in 1933 — the coldest on record in the northern **\Z**hemisphere since the beginning of the 20th century. **\Z**

Yet despite the harsh climate, people live in the valley, and the area **\(\Delta\)** is equipped with schools, a post office, a bank, and even an airport **\(\Delta\)** runway (albeit open only in the summer).
