

## Austria Approves Extradition of Russian Mob Boss Gagiev

An Austrian court has approved the extradition of notorious ■Russian mob boss Aslan Gagiev, the Kommersant newspaper reported Tuesday.

Gagiev's gang is accused of carrying out 60 murders in Moscow⊠and the North Caucuses, including the killing of a deputy vice-president for Russia's⊠North Ossetia.

It's the third time which the Viennese court has granted the request for Gagiev's extradition following several appeals.

The crime lord's extradition was finally approved after ■Russian guarantees that Gagiev's trial and detention would be monitored by ■Austrian diplomats to ensure international laws were being met.

Gagiev, who was arrested by Austrian police at a Vienna⊠train station in January 2015, had been released on bail worth 100,000 euros in⊠March this year.

An Austrian judge had previously approved his extradition to ■Bulgaria, where Gagiev was wanted on fraud charges. Bulgarian authorities have ■since dropped the case.
