

20% of Moscow's December Snowfall to Arrive in Next 24 Hours

Moscow is set to receive 20 percent of its December snowfall in the next 24 hours, [the Interfax news agency has reported.](#)

Eleven millimeters of snow is expected to hit the capital on Monday, Dec. 5, as temperatures rise to a balmy 3 degrees Celsius.

Twelve flights have already been cancelled at Moscow's Sheremetyevo airport, with at least 18 more facing major delays. Seven flights are already expected to be delayed on Tuesday, [the Aeroflot website announced.](#)

The snow is set to continue through Tuesday night, Interfax reported.

Some 90cm of snow has already fallen in the city this winter, ☒suspending train routes and leaving thousands in the Moscow region ☒without power.

The first snowfall in Moscow this year occurred on Oct. 27, the earliest ☒recorded snow since weather observations began 137 years ago.
