Children who need special care and support will have a chance to immerse themselves in a world of magic as they watch the fairy-tale ballet "The Sleeping Beauty" performed on stage at the Mikhailovsky Theater. But in this version of the ballet classic, a few familiar Disney characters will make an appearance.

The performance is part of a social program launched by Disney in Russia in 2011 in collaboration with the Mikhailovsky Theater, when 600 young guests from around the country were invited to the premiere of an unusual ballet premiere.
