

Russia Introduces Free Visas for Country's Far East

Russia is set to introduce a new e-visa scheme for tourists visiting the country's Far East.

The new visas will be issued free of ■charge for the Primorye, Khabarovsk, Sakhalin, Chukotka and Kamchatka ■regions.

Foreign visitors will be asked to⊠fill out an online form in order to receive a visa, which will be⊠valid for visits lasting up to eight days.

The scheme, which is the**¤**first of its kind in Russia, in planned to be ready for the start of the**¤**third Eastern Economic Forum from Sept. 6-7**¤**in the city of Vladivostok , <u>said Alexander</u> <u>Galushka</u>, Russia's**¤**Minister of Development for the Far East.
