

Moscow Police Detain 19 Vegans at May Day Parade

Moscow police detained 19 leftist and vegan activists during Monday's May Day parade.

Vladimir Zhuravlev, a member of the "Leftist Bloc," told the website Mediazona, that the group of vegan activists was reportedly detained for displaying a gay pride flag.

Police later released everyone without pressing charges.
