The Moscow Times is set to release its final print edition on Thursday, July 6 with a special souvenir issue.

Dutch businessman Derk Sauer ■ announced in June that The Moscow Times brand would be moved to a ■ charitable foundation in partnership with the publication's ■ current owner, Demyan Kudryavtsev.

The⊠decision sees the publication move to a web-only format, with the⊠majority of staff losing their jobs.

"Throughout its existence, The Moscow Times has remained dedicated to independent reporting and excellence in journalism," said outgoing editor Mikhail Fishman. "It has

played a unique role in covering Russian affairs and politics from the inside. I hope it will continue to stick to these principles throughout the future."
