

Russian Foreign Ministry Vows Retaliation After Twitter Blocks RT and Sputnik Ads

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Russia's Foreign Ministry has called Twitter's decision to drop advertising by two Kremlinfounded media outlets an "aggressive move."

"This is yet another aggressive move aimed at blocking the activities of Russia Today as a result of part of the American establishment and secret services," the ministry's spokeswoman Maria Zakharova <u>wrot</u>e in a statement on Facebook. "Naturally, there will be retaliatory measures."

Twitter <u>announced</u> on Thursday it would be "off-boarding" advertising from the Kremlinfunded news outlets Russia Today (RT) and Sputnik.

The decision is a response to allegations of Russian meddling in the 2016 U.S. presidential elections.

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
