

The IOC Will Announce If Russia is Banned From Winter Games in Early December

The International Olympic Committee (IOC) will <u>announce</u> Dec. 5 if Russia can compete at the next Olympics in South Korea.

Russia faces a ban from the February games in Pyeongchang after the World-Anti Doping Agency (WADA) <u>ruled</u> Nov. 15 for the third year running that Russia's anti-doping agency is not meeting international standards.

WADA's ruling puts pressure on the IOC to ban Russia from the upcoming Winter Games.
