

Migrants Riot to Demand Faster Deportation From Russia

A riot has erupted at a migrant detention facility in Siberia where undocumented immigrants demanded better treatment and a faster deportation process.

Around 20 inmates burnt mattresses, smashed CCTV cameras and barricaded themselves inside the detention center last Saturday, the Krasnoyarsk regional Investigative Committee has said in a statement.

"The main demands of the participants were to improve detention conditions and a faster deportation to their homeland," the regional Investigative Committee <u>said</u> on Thursday.

Police and National Guard troops broke up the unrest, placing two of the organizers of the riot into custody and detaining a third for arson.

Authorities have launched an investigation into the incident.
