

Mysterious Pillars of Light Cover St. Petersburg Night Sky

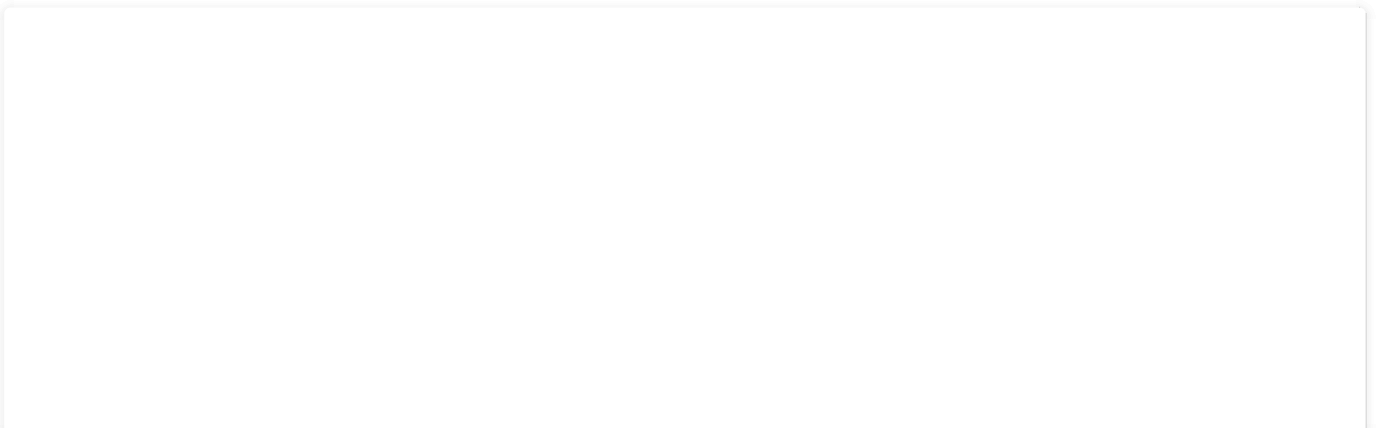

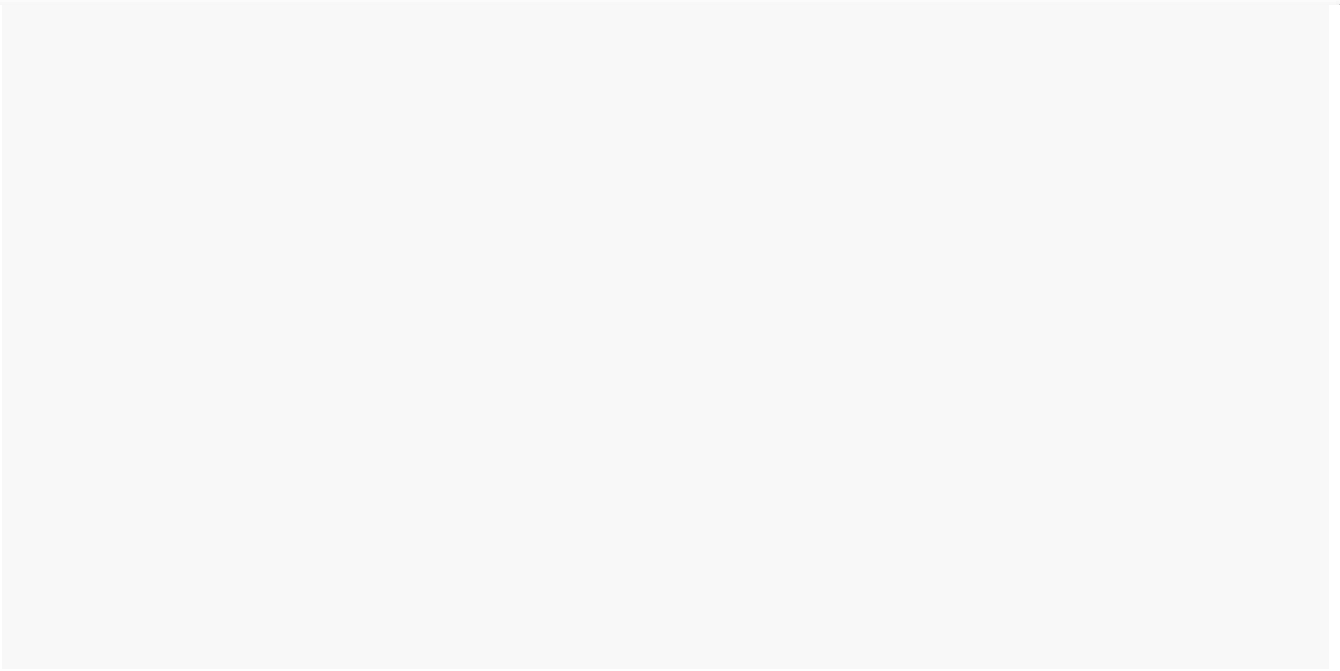

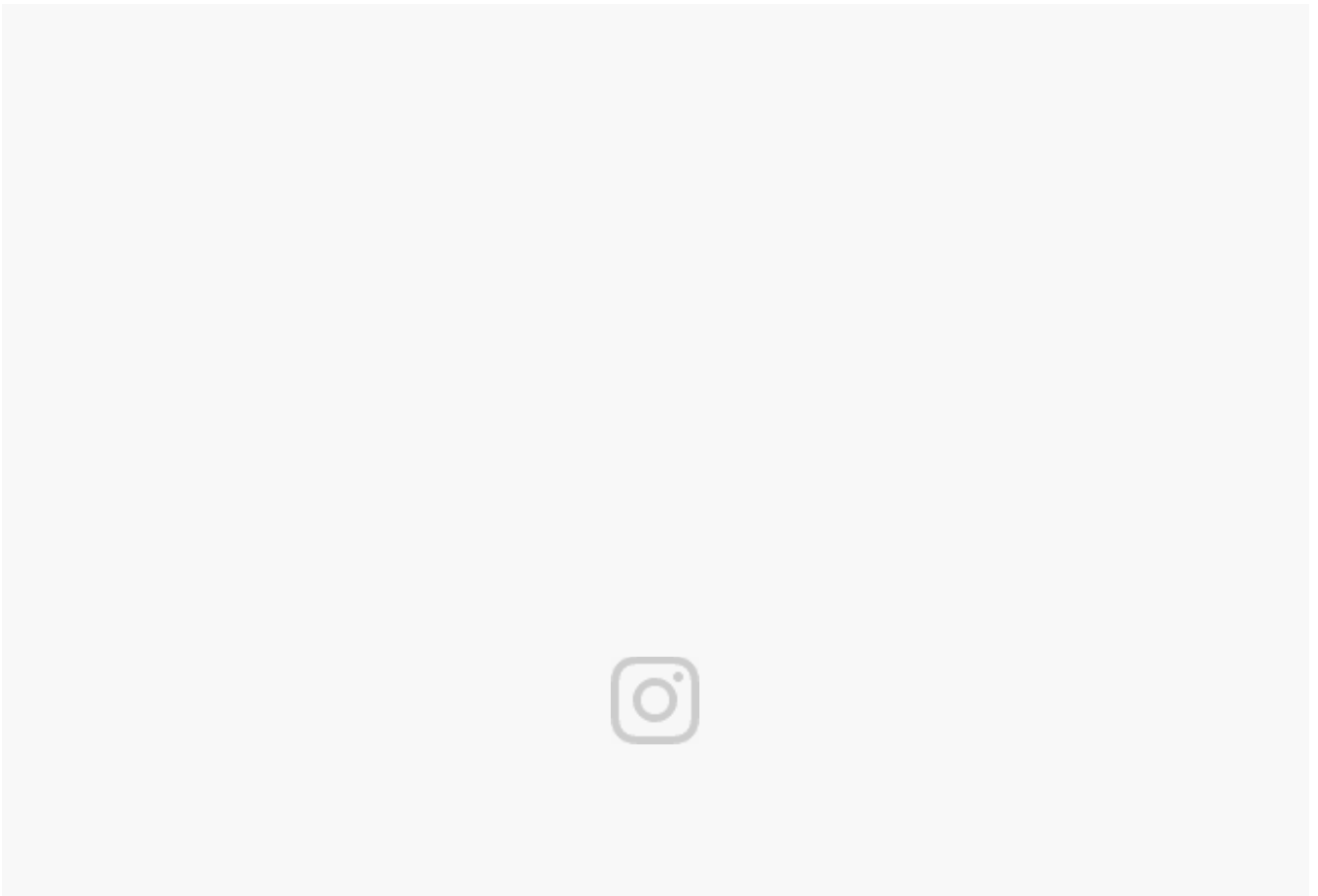
