

Russian Social Media Laughs, Canonizes After Stunning World Cup Win

The outpouring of joy following Russia's victory over Spain may have <u>reminded</u> the Kremlin of Soviet-era celebrations after World War II, but the age of social media gave the scenes a 21st-century makeover.

Russia defied the odds by beating Spain on Sunday to advance to the World Cup quarterfinals, sending thousands of ecstatic Russians in the tournament host country to the <u>streets</u>, where they <u>celebrated well into the night</u>.

Goalkeeper Igor Akinfeev gained the immediate status of <u>national hero</u> after making a crucial save with the <u>tip of his toe</u> during penalty shootouts.

In fact, Akinfeev's foot was <u>put on a pedestal</u> within minutes of Russia's victory, earning it the nickname "<u>Foot of God</u>" among Russian Twitter users.

Photoshop artists <u>picked up</u> the <u>religious</u> theme and <u>ran with it</u>. "Russia just officially canonized Akinfeev's left foot," Reuters correspondent Polina Ivanova <u>tweeted</u>.

The social media spotlight also <u>turned</u> on three <u>unsuspecting</u> hot dog eating fans in traditional Russian headdresses during the game's extra time, <u>inspiring</u> a <u>variety</u> of <u>memes</u>.

Cartoonist Sergei Elkin made a mashup of the two memes, depicting the three fans <u>carrying</u> Akinfeev's foot on their shoulders.

Later, TV reporters <u>discovered</u> the identity of two of the fans: a fashion designer and an employee of a state contractor that runs Moscow Mayor Sergei Sobyanin's re-election campaign.

"It's very strange: we [just] came to cheer for the team [and] had a bite of hot dogs," the fans told Russia's Dozhd TV news channel. "Sausages, by the way, lead to victory."
