

Putin Makes Vladivostok the Capital of Russia's Far East, Replacing Khabarovsk

President Vladimir Putin <u>signed</u> a decree Thursday making Vladivostok the capital of Russia's Far Eastern Federal District, replacing the old capital of Khabarovsk.

In October 2018, the acting governor of Primorsky Krai, Oleg Kozhemyako, <u>proposed</u> to transfer the capital of the Far Eastern Federal District from Khabarovsk to Vladivostok, citing economic incentives.

The proposal was met with criticism by officials in Khabarovsk. Both the <u>mayor</u> of Khabarovsk and the <u>governor</u> of the region publicly expressed their opposition to the proposal.
