

'Russia's Oldest Woman' Dies Aged 128 in North Caucasus

A woman who is reported to be the oldest in Russia has died in the North Caucasus at age 128, local officials announced Monday.

The Russian Book of Records <u>certified</u> Nano Shaova as the country's oldest person on July 4, 2017, when her age was given as 126 years, 11 months and 19 days.

Shaova's death was <u>announced</u> by district authorities in Russia's North Caucasus republic of Kabardino-Balkaria.
