

Russian Blogger Dives Under Ice in Frozen Lake, Reports Feeling 'Refreshed'

As freezing weather <u>enveloped</u> parts of the nation, one Russian fitness blogger took matters into his own hands and turned the winter into his friend.

The blogger, Yegor Lesnoy, channeled his inner Iceman as he filmed himself diving under the frozen ice of Lake Baikal in Siberia, where temperatures dipped to minus 30 degrees Celsius. The lake, he claims, was a balmy 1 C.

"I simply swam 10 meters under the ice of my favorite lake and came up absolutely happy, refreshed and healthy," Lesnoy wrote in a post <u>published</u> Monday.

A similar video dated Jan. 9 describes the author <u>hearing</u> ice cracking underwater, saying "I can't compare this sound to anything else, it's absolutely otherworldly."

Lesnoy's Instagram account <u>features similar</u> winter-themed footage, including fitness routines <u>performed</u> underwater.

"What can be better than going out on the porch in the morning, breathing in the frosty air so that the snot freezes in your nose?" he <u>writes</u> in one of the posts.
