

Russia's Investigative Committee Seeks Donations for Archangel Statue, Reports Say

The head of Russia's Investigative Committee is reportedly seeking donations for the construction of a bronze Archangel Michael statue at the entrance of his agency's new headquarters in Moscow as religious symbols gain an increasingly prominent place in Russian state institutions.

The Russian Orthodox Church has become a powerful political force since the <u>anointment</u> of Patriarch Kirill as its leader in 2009. Last year, the Russian military began <u>collecting</u> donations for its state-of-the-art military cathedral with six golden domes dedicating to the patron saint of each military branch.

Alexander Bastrykin now plans to erect a three-meter bronze sculpture of the Russian Investigative Committee's patron saint – <u>Archangel Michael</u> – in Moscow, the RBC news website <u>reported</u> Friday.

Citing one of Bastrykin's deputies' written orders, RBC writes that at least one department had agreed to deduct 1,500 rubles (\$22.7) from their paychecks for the 13 million ruble (\$200,000) construction effort.

"The figure of the main fighter against lawlessness on a pedestal – trampling a snake with a spear – symbolizes victory of the forces of light over the forces of darkness," RBC quotes the letter as saying.

The monument will reportedly serve the dual purpose of decorating the new Investigative Committee office's entrance and "promoting the youth's spiritual and moral upbringing." An unnamed source inside the Investigative Committee confirmed the letter's authenticity, RBC said.

The outlet previously reported that construction of the Investigative Committee's 5.6 billion ruble new headquarters began in 2015 and is scheduled to wrap up in 2019.
