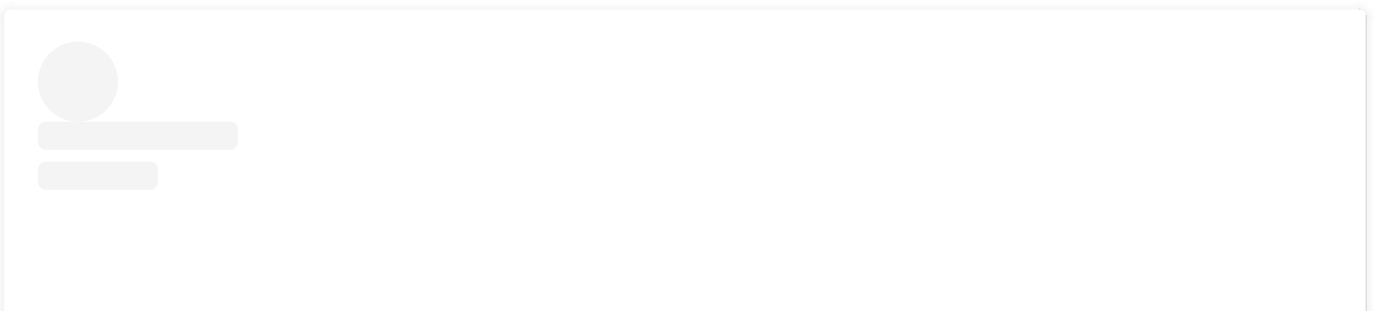

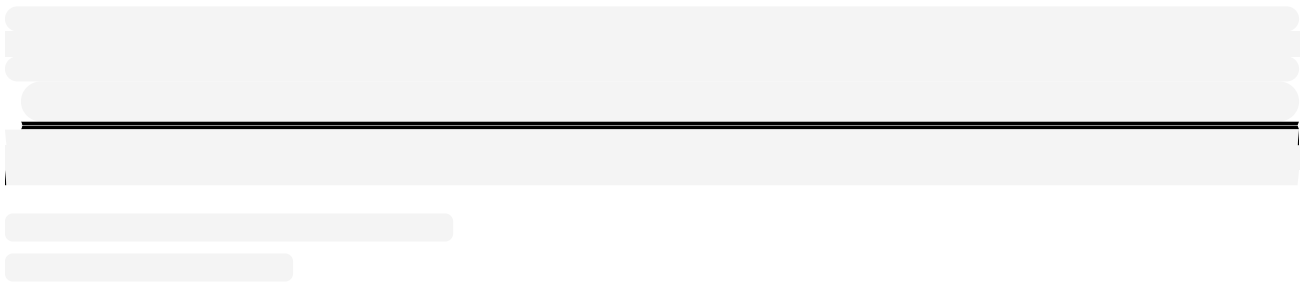
A mysterious purple glow descends on Leningrad region.

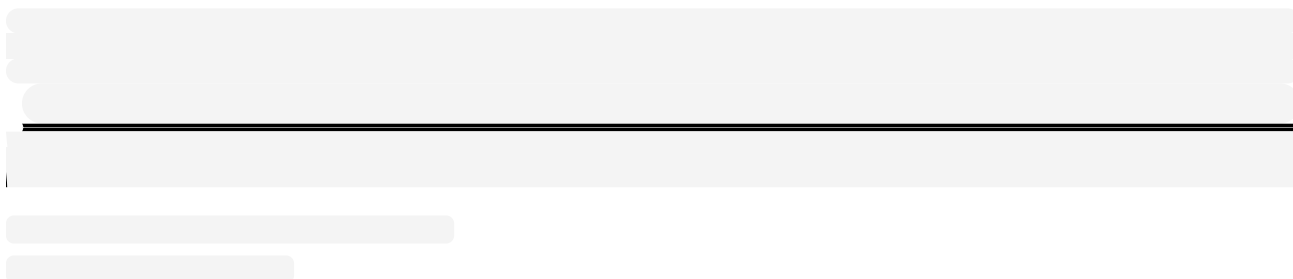
Over the horizon, there are more colors still.
