

5 Russian Security Officers Arrested for Robbery

Five Russian security service officers have been arrested and two placed under house arrest by a military court in Moscow on charges of robbery, Interfax <u>reported</u> on Friday.

Previous conflicting reports had said six unnamed Federal Security Service (FSB) officers had been detained on suspicion of either <u>embezzlement</u> or <u>robbery</u> on Thursday.

After initially reporting that six officers were detained, Russia's RBC news website later <u>confirmed</u> with the court that legal action had been taken against seven people. Five were reportedly placed in pre-trial custody and two under house arrest.

They face up to 15 years in prison if found guilty of robbery committed by a group.

The FSB said in a statement on its website Tuesday that an unknown number of its officers

had been <u>detained</u> on suspicion of embezzling an entrepreneur's money.
