

The mysterious disappearance of a reservoir an hour's drive from St. Petersburg has baffled local residents.

Images on social media [show](#) an [archipelago](#) in place of Lazurnoye Ozero (Azure Lake), a popular weekend getaway for city dwellers measuring roughly 200 meters by 200 meters.
