

Leopard Print-Clad Women Offered Free Moscow Zoo Entry

Moscow Zoo will welcome women wearing leopard print on International Women's Day this Sunday in a move it says is "in support of wild cats."

During the March 8 promotion, women wearing "large visible items" will be granted free entry to the zoo.
