
People across the Russian-speaking world are transforming their balconies into raves while in quarantine. **Cream Soda / Youtube**

During the coronavirus quarantine, Russians are dancing on their own — and loving it.



Here's a look at our favorite balcony-dancers:


Some, like @godukgoduk from Latvia's capital of Riga, incorporate dance into their morning routine. Coffee, vogue, repeat.

















Teamwork was the modus operandi for @nikolkaplan of Nizhny Novgorod.
