

In Photos: Russia Celebrates Western Easter Sunday

While most Russians, as followers of the Orthodox Christian traditions, will mark Easter on May 2, the country's Protestant and Catholic parishes took part in the Western-style celebrations on Sunday. Marking the holiday amid the pandemic, Russia's Christian believers had to forgo some Easter rituals such as foot washing and the ceremonial kissing of the cross, but the Easter Sunday church services proceeded as usual.
