

At Least 8 Killed in Moscow Region Hostel Fire

At least eight people were killed and one other was injured in a hostel fire in the Moscow region town of Istra, emergency officials <u>said</u> Friday.

The fire broke out at 4:00 a.m. local time and was extinguished around five hours later, the Emergency Situations Ministry's local branch<u>said</u>, according to the news agency Moskva.

A video shared by Russia's Emergency Situations Ministry showed the charred remains of the building.

The Moscow region prosecutor's office <u>said</u> an unidentified 23-year-old man had rented the building and sublet it to undocumented migrants. The law enforcement body said it launched a criminal investigation into the organization of illegal migration following the incident.

Russia's Investigative Committee, which probes major crimes, $\underline{launched}$ a separate investigation into negligent homicide.

The state-run news agency RIA Novosti, citing an anonymous emergency official, <u>reported</u> that the Istra hostel fire may have spread from a fireplace and people may have died from smoke inhalation.
