

Ukrainian Drone Strike Kills Woman in Belgorod, as Russia Accuses Kyiv of Targeting Nuclear Plant

A woman was killed in a Ukrainian drone strike in the southwestern city of Belgorod, regional officials <u>said</u> on Friday, after the Russian Defense Ministry reported downing hundreds of drones across the country overnight.

Belgorod region Governor Vyachelsav Gladkov confirmed the woman's death but did not provide further details. Local Telegram news channels <u>shared</u> photos of police cordoning off a bus stop and covering a body with aluminum foil.

Around an hour later, Gladkov <u>said</u> a civilian was injured in a separate strike on the nearby village of Krasny Oktyabr, located 13 kilometers (8 miles) from the Ukrainian border.

Russia's Defense Ministry <u>said</u> it shot down 10 Ukrainian drones over the Belgorod region between 8 a.m. and 9:15 a.m. Friday, though it did not say whether any reached their targets.

The military <u>said</u> it intercepted 221 Ukrainian drones across Russia overnight. More than half were reportedly downed in the Bryansk and Smolensk regions, which border Belarus and where joint Russian-Belarusian military exercises are underway.

In Smolensk, a drone targeted a nuclear power plant around 4 a.m. local time, according to the state nuclear agency Rosatom. Air defense systems were said to have destroyed the drone near the facility.

Rosatom said the power plant remains operational and there was no change in radiation levels.

In the northwestern Leningrad region, 28 drones were shot down, according to local officials. A fire <u>broke out</u> on a vessel in the coastal town of Primorsk, but Leningrad region Governor Alexander Drozdenko <u>said</u> the blaze was quickly put out.

Primorsk, located on the Gulf of Finland, is Russia's largest oil-loading port, handling about 72 million tons of crude annually.
