

5 Killed in Ukrainian Drone Attack on Belgorod, Russia Says

Updated death toll.

Five people died in a Ukrainian overnight drone attack on the Russian city of Belgorod, the regional crisis center said on Sunday.

Alexander Shuvayev, the acting Governor of Belgorod region, earlier said three people were killed and 25 others, including two children, were injured. The death toll later rose to five.

Shuvayev said the attack sparked fires in two apartment buildings and a large number of residential and non-residential buildings were damaged.

Russia's Defense Ministry said it had destroyed more than 150 Ukrainian drones over the European part of the country, as well as over annexed Crimea, the Black Sea and the Sea of Azov.

In Novorossiysk, a major Russian export port on the Black Sea, drone debris fell on two facilities, Mayor Alexander Kravchenko said, without identifying the sites.

In Russia's Bashkortostan region, a Ukrainian drone struck a building under construction and a crane in the city of Ufa, state-run RIA news agency reported, citing local emergency services

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
