

One Killed in Ukrainian Attack on Wildberries Logistics Center in Voronezh

A Ukrainian drone attack killed one person and injured two others in the southwestern Voronezh region, local officials said Tuesday, with online retailer Wildberries saying that a fire broke out at one of its logistics centers during the air assault.

Voronezh region Governor Alexander Gusev [said](#) a 49-year-old man died after being hospitalized for injuries he sustained from falling drone debris. He said two others, one of whom had been at a “large logistics center” during the attack, remained hospitalized.

Wildberries [confirmed](#) that its logistics center was struck and said it evacuated all of its employees. The company later [said](#) firefighters managed to put out a blaze that erupted at the facility, adding that “most” of the goods stored there were undamaged.

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Separately, in the Orenburg region near the border with Kazakhstan, local authorities [said](#) a Ukrainian drone attack sparked a fire at an “industrial enterprise.” No injuries were reported.

The Ukrainian military [said](#) it attacked the Orsknefteorgsintez oil refinery, located around 1,500 kilometers (930 miles) away from the border with Ukraine. Kyiv has repeatedly [targeted](#) the facility since the 2022 invasion.

Owned by businessman Mikhail Gutseriyev’s Safmar Group, Orsknefteorgsintez is one of Russia’s leading refineries with an annual processing capacity of 6.6 million metric tons. The facility produces about 30 types of petroleum products, including gasoline, diesel, jet fuel, bitumen and fuel oil.

Russia’s Defense Ministry [said](#) it intercepted 396 Ukrainian drones across Russia and annexed Crimea between Monday night and Tuesday morning.

Meanwhile, in Ukraine, local authorities said at least six people were killed in Russian strikes in the southern city of Zaporizhzhia.

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
